
There are other major issues currently facing us and I will work to protect the interests of Walton South. We await the

My 6-Point Plan for Walton South

- 1 Acting on the needs of Walton residents.** I will always listen and be accessible to residents of Walton South by phone, email, post or in person, and communicate regularly by newsletter.
